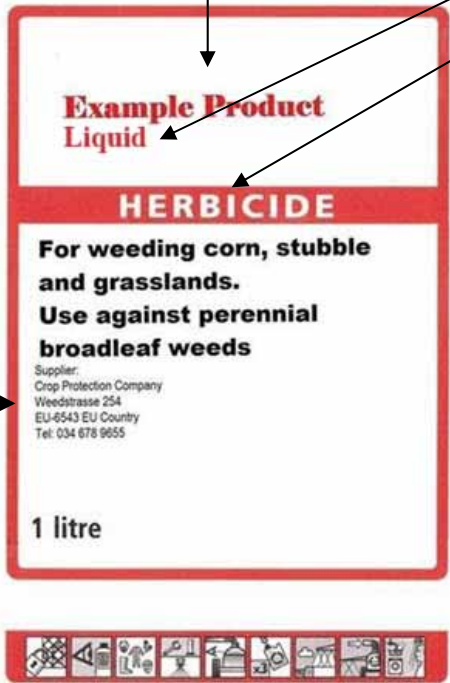


Guidance on labelling and packaging in accordance with the CLP Regulation

Designation of the product (product identifier)

Information which is obligatory under Article 16(1) (c), (i), (j) and (k) of Directive 91/414/EEC



Supplier identity

Non-obligatory supplemental icons

Fold-out booklet, removable by tearing off the cover: it contains information which reflects Article 16(1) (l), (m) and (n) of Directive 91/414/EEC (not shown)
